

## Minutes

PSMA Energy Efficiency Committee May 17, 2012

The meeting convened by phone at 10 CDT.

Discussion of the web site, the improvements to the energy efficiency database and the EEDBR system are postponed until Arnold Alderman and Dusty Becker can participate.

Rich Fassler gave an overview of the DOE Battery Charger & External Power Supplies Efficiency standard initiative. Rich attended the DOE meeting of May 2, 2012 and had circulated a report. He summarized the report.

After a discussion, the committee asked Rich to accept a suggested letter supporting the proposed standard and to edit as he thinks is appropriate to reflect the committee's position. Rich will then circulate the letter to the members of the committee to invite comments. Update: Arnold Alderman has accepted this action item.

If there are no objections, the letter will be sent on behalf of the committee (not PSMA as a whole). Because the deadline for response is May 29<sup>th</sup>, if there are any comments or suggestions, they will have to be resolved by exchange of emails.

We discussed the workshop for APEC 2012. Getting EPRI involvement is important, and I will continue to try to contact Brian Fontenbery. If EPRI is not responsive, or does not follow through, we may have to consider sponsoring the workshop alone or finding another partner. Time is short, so that needs to be resolved at the next meeting.

The subcommittee, Arnold Alderman, Dusty Becker, Mohan Mankikar and I will try to meet by phone as soon as possible to keep this moving.

We discussed at more length the industry session for APEC 2012. We are agreed on the theme, Power Management, but will have to reduce the topics to seven. I accepted an action item to send an email to Fred Lee to see if VTech will participate. I have done so, but do not yet have a response
