- **Initiatives**

- **IPC PS SW/FW Standard Collaboration**

- ○ The new IPC standard request process continues even as MOU terms are discussed/negotiated amongst the leadership teams of each org. The financial arrangement is still being worked out, but was determined to not be a hindrance to the request process. Once finances are settled, **WE SHALL NEED TO SUBMIT A SPECIAL PROJECT REQUEST TO PSMA BOD** to summarize any logistical and/or financial support needs from PSMA.
- ○ **NOTE:** there is now a **CALL FOR PARTICIPATION** in this new IPC standard committee. Be sure you and/or your org are on the ground floor of this new area of standardization for power supplies. **Please contact Eric and/or Brian if you have interest and/or questions about the commitment.**

- **SW/FW Flowchart Subproject**

- ○ There is a draft going around for this effort, but it seems there is little interest and I have no time to drive so I am suggesting we leverage the current efforts into the new IPC collaboration on a standard.
